- **Dress Code that my child will adhere to: The students will adhere to the appropriate dress code outlined for this event: Students should be dressed in comfortable "creative casual" clothing and comfortable shoes. PLEASE NO LEGGINGS, BIKER SHORTS, RIPPED JEANS OR CUT OFF SHIRTS. (Please contact Natasha Davis should there be any extenuating circumstances regarding the dress code).**
