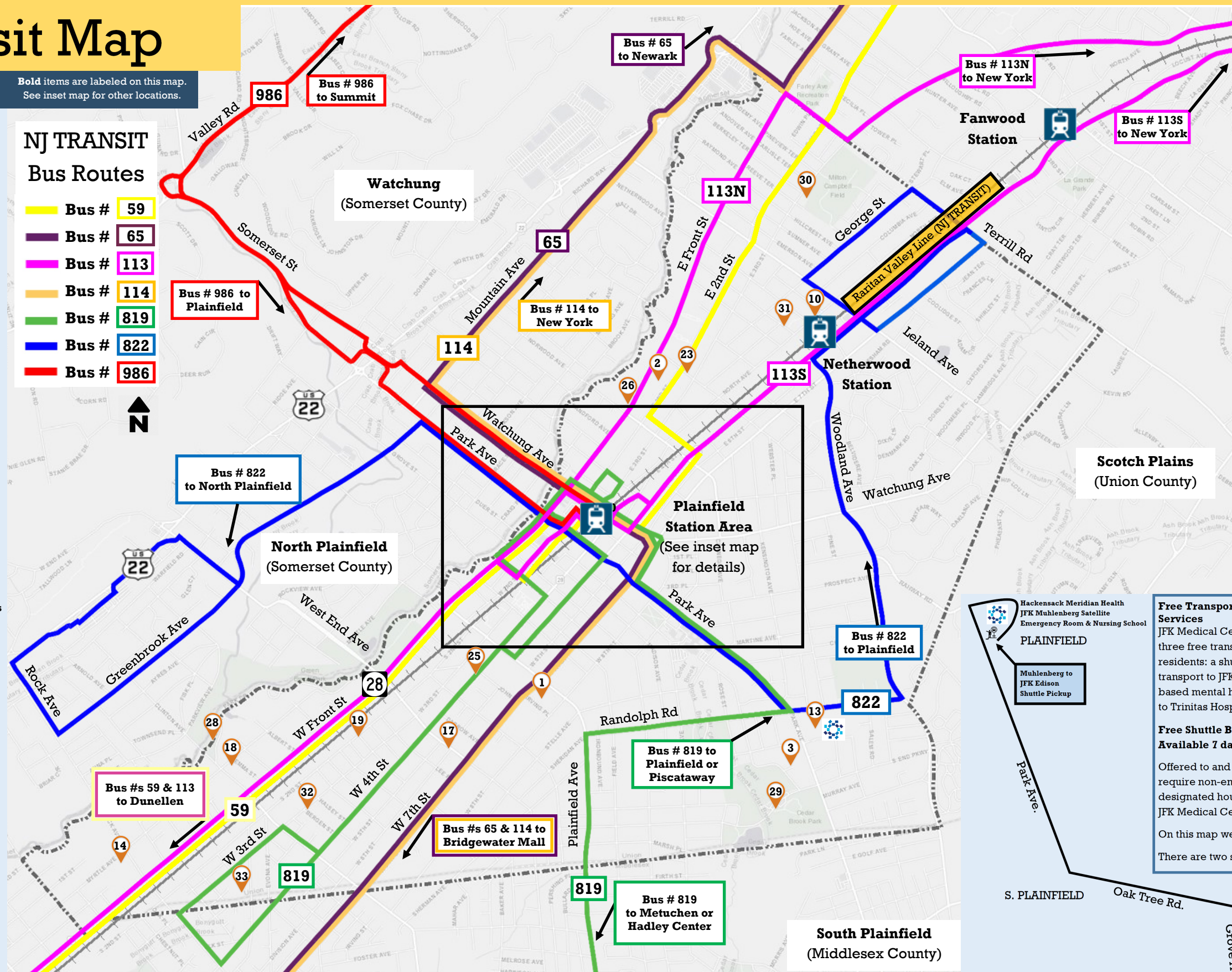

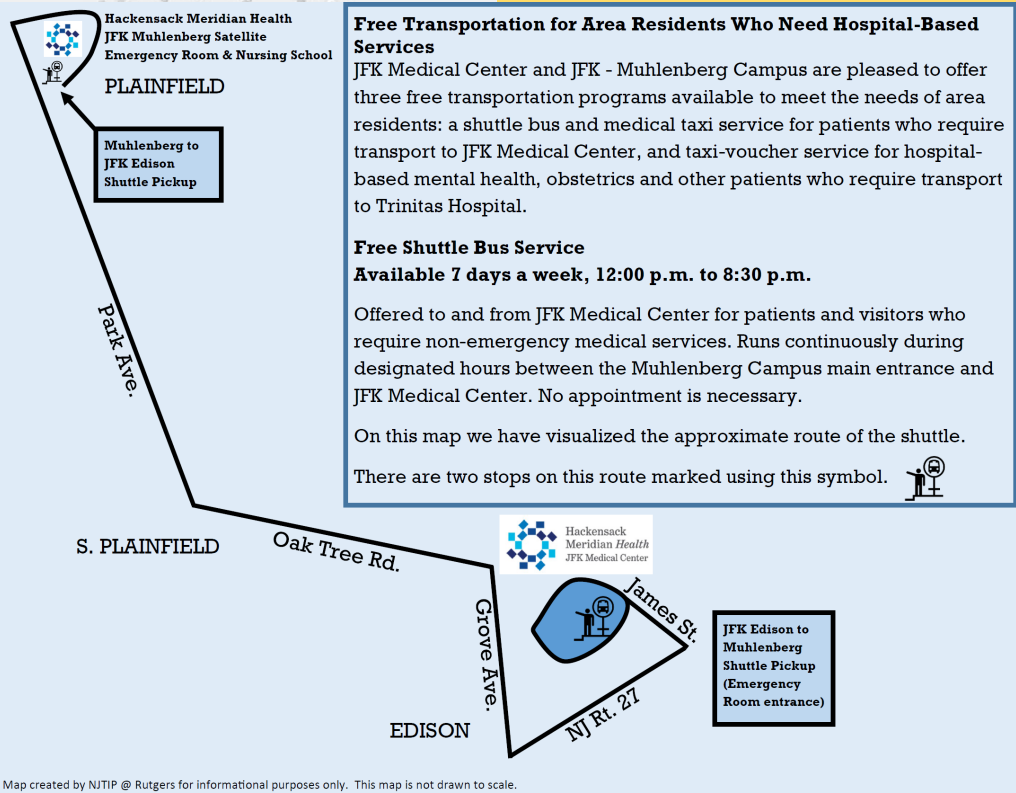
Free Shuttle Bus Service

Available 7 days a week, 12:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Offered to and from JFK Medical Center for patients and visitors who require non-emergency medical services. Runs continuously during designated hours between the Muhlenberg Campus main entrance and JFK Medical Center. No appointment is necessary.
