The Gaps in Elizabeth:

- 26.1% of Elizabeth residents earn an income below the poverty level
- 8.5% of residents earn an income that is less than half of the poverty level
- Males 16-17 years old are the largest demographic of those under the poverty line
- Over 15,000 Hispanics in Elizabeth live under the poverty line
- Almost 1/3 of all children in Elizabeth live under the poverty line
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: <u>Attention to filling these gaps will reduce the cost burden to</u> <u>society later: health care cost, better workforce, and stronger communities.</u>

• Job and Skill Shortage

O Need for training, networking, apprenticeship, and job placement programs

• **Solution:** Support and Expand the **YEPP** Program

- The Youth Employment Pathways (YEPP) Program assists in-school and out-of-school youth with the necessary tools to successfully secure employment
- Develop professional and entrepreneurial skills, leadership development, and financial literacy
- Programs include career planning, education and training, and work experience
 - **\$500** provides transportation for 10 youth during their internship
 - **\$750** provides tutoring and GED services for 10 youth
 - **\$1000** sponsors a year-long internship for a youth
